



- installing a leather belt

Leather Treadle Belts

Come with a page of directions with illustrations to install plus 2 red spool pin felts for your machine. Belts are 3/16 inches thick and 72 inches long with hook at end, you cut to fit your machine. As with leather shoes, a treadle belt will stretch and needs to be tightened now and then so it will not slip.


Tip: Missing a clip or have one that is so hard you can't open or bend it? Make your own from most any wire or sew the belt together with heavy duty thread or dental floss. Regular size paper clip or florist wire are good choices. Use needle nose pliers to bend.

Tip of keeping belt in top shape



It tends to get stuck top dead center like this.


Rotate the main wheel by hand to allow the foot treadle to work.



An oil hole is on main shaft for WD-40

 Anti-reverse rubber ball

Screw to replace 3/4" rubber ball
